Existing investors include EQT Ventures, Menlo Ventures and Workday Ventures. In total, Sana has raised USD 62 million in Series B funding making Sana one of Europe's most highly-funded AI companies.

Sana was founded in 2016 by Joel Hellermark and the company's mission is to augment human intelligence through artificial intelligence. With this purpose, the company has developed a AI-platform that empowers organizations to find, share, and harness the knowledge they need to achieve their missions through combining the best of enterprise search, a learning management system, meeting tools, and a knowledge management system into one single platform.
