

DLA Piper has advised EQT Ventures on its investment in Heart Aerospace



DLA Piper has advised EQT Ventures on its recent investment in Heart Aerospace, a company with headquarters in Gothenburg that develops and manufactures hybrid-electric airplanes. The Company successfully raised approximately USD 107 million in funding with the participation from EQT Ventures, Bill Gate's Breakthrough Energy Ventures and Lower Carbon.

Heart Aerospace intends to use the funds to further build its business and make progress toward type certification of the company's first hybrid-electric airplane, the ES-30. The ES-30 is a regional airplane with a seating capacity of 30 passengers that offers lower emissions, lower noise pollution and lower operating costs on short haul routes than current conventionally fueled airplanes.
